



**RESOLUTION #2 – FROM GWICH’IN TRIBAL COUNCIL**

**ENHANCE TOURISM INFRASTRUCTURE SERVICES ALONG THE DEMPSTER HIGHWAY**

**Whereas** The Western Arctic Region of the Northwest Territories experiences a large number of visitors by road each year; and

**Whereas** the number of visitors via road is expected to increase in coming years; and

**Whereas** additional facilities would enhance the visitor experience, as well as the resident experience during the tourism season; and

**Whereas** there are no washroom facilities or turnouts along the Inuvik to Tuktoyaktuk highway, and a lack of waste disposal receptacles at the Peel and Mackenzie River ferry crossings.

**Be it resolved** that NWT Tourism advocate to the Department of Infrastructure, Government of the Northwest Territories, to provide these services at the locations identified above and adequately maintain said services.
